



Sustainability Summer Camp Overview

Who: 4th- 6th graders

What: An interactive, interconnected summer day camp that promotes the sustainability of self, sustainability of community, and sustainability of the environment by merging science and the arts to create a fun, engaging, educational, and transformational experience that fosters empathy and a commitment to serve others.

The Sustainability Summer Camp involves traditional environmental and outdoor education, but fuses it with the arts (music, dance, and theatre) and focus on local issues of students' concern. The curriculum seeks to encourage:

- sustainability of self through fitness, nutrition, and mindfulness
- sustainability of community by engaging in social justice issues and service learning
- sustainability of the environment by educating about natural systems and how our actions can positively or negatively affect these systems



Duration: Over a five day consecutive period

Purpose: To educate students about social and environmental topics, explore relevant issues in their community, brainstorm solutions to these problems, and share their findings with the community through a performance modeled after Queen Green's Eco-Rhymes!
